Something to think about when you ride in the Mountains

Due to the change of Seasons and Weather, please keep in mind when riding on curvy roads. Only go so fast, that you can stop within view distance. Stay on the left side of your lane, until you can see all the way through the corner. Making sure no obstacles are in the way, constantly looking for debris on the road. In a curve, don't add throttle and lean at the same time this can make your back tire lose traction. Damp roads can be slick especially, when wet leaves are on the pavement. Also, let someone know where you are riding to, call or text them when you get back. Therefore, if something does happen they will know the general area you are riding.
